The Institute operates under the vision and mission statements of Global Outreach Developments International. The Institute's first function is to pursue fulfillment of said mission and vision statements. Our participants will learn to think critically and constructively with faith and will never bow at the feet of reasoned speculation, but will bow only at the feet of God.

Our approach to the Scripture is one of canonical authority and interpretation. We approach the Scripture as God's word to us, a word above every word written or spoken. We go to God's word to learn and be changed, not to confirm declarative statements. Our participants will be educated in all the theories of academia while also learning how to apply faith to said theories and either accept or reject said theories.

Mission

Equipping a globally conscious community to serve the poor and marginalized through education, advocacy and empowerment, without discrimination, demonstrating unconditional love.

Vision

We are a movement that transplants communities of global denizens, who in solidarity with the poor and marginalized embody ethics of justice and freedom to bring about societal transformation where education and autonomy exist for all, without discrimination. We do not value popular American ideals associated with violence, domination, neocolonialism and the attitude that the country has favored nation status with God and is unaccountable to the voice of the global community. Instead, as an educated community who values the preservation of life as governed by the ethical teachings of the Bible, we will empower global citizens to implement the justice of God in their societies, through non-violent activity focused on education and capacity development of the poor and marginalized, as demonstrated in the life and message of Jesus of Nazareth.

Undergraduate Application Instructions

The following steps must be taken in order to complete your request for entrance into an academic program of the Institute for G.O.D. Int'l:

1. Application for Admission (Please type all information)

- a. Complete and sign the application. Please make sure you are aware of the program's mission and vision for students before signing the application.
- b. Autobiography is to be submitted with Application
 - i. Each applicant must submit a typed autobiography of their Christian experience and journey, and reason why the applicant desires to attend the program of the Institute for G.O.D. Int'l. We require that this be of your own work and that you explain yourself clearly and concisely.

2. Transcripts

- a. Applicant is responsible for requesting an Official Transcript(s) to be sent from all previous or current high schools that he/she has attended and each college he/she has attended, to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. (May be submitted after the Application)

3. References

- a. Each applicant must submit two Letters of Reference from people familiar with the applicant's character that have known the applicant for at least two years. Letters of Reference may not be written by relatives of the applicant, current students at the Institute for G.O.D. Int'l, or by other applicants to the Institute for G.O.D. Int'l. (Must be submitted with Application)

4. Application Fee(s)

- a. A \$40 Application Fee is due upon reception of the participant's application. Make check or money order payable to G.O.D. Int'l. Please indicate your name on your check or money order. Do not send cash. This fee is not refundable. *See below deadline for variations of this fee.

5. In-Person Interview

- a. The finalization of the application process requires an in-person interview process. Applications will be contacted to set up this time if and when applicable.

The Institute recognizes homeschooling as a viable education and welcomes applications from qualified homeschooled students. Please submit an official transcript or a GED with application. All application documents and transcript(s) must be in our office by the application's deadline so files can be evaluated by the Admissions Committee.

- November 1st- Application Deadline (\$40)
- After November 1st- (\$50) (Final deadline is December 1st)
